Housing

The Residential Rehabilitation Program (RRP) serves adult individuals with a diagnosis of chronic mental illness. This program consists of several residences with different levels of care from intensive, 24-hour, 7 days per week to General level drop-in supports in a community setting. We provide individualized rehabilitation in a home-like setting where consumers take an active role in their treatment.

All referrals for RRP should be sent to the local Core Service Agency (CSA) who, in turn, will prioritize referrals to the RRP as placements are available. The residential staff will then meet with the prospective resident for a screening process and determine the most appropriate level of housing.
