Veterans Housing Outreach and Assistance Services For Veterans Newly or Nearly Homeless

Beginning October 15 2011, Alliance serves Veterans with very low-income in the Baltimore area who recently became homeless or who are on the verge of becoming homeless. Through the All-Vets HOAM project, Alliance-Veterans Housing Outreach and Assistance in Metro-Baltimore, Alliance provides:

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Case management

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Linkages to housing resources

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Financial assistance to secure permanent housing
